
HOW TO HELP REBUILD UKRAINE IN PLANNED AND REGULATED MANNER?



After a year of war destroyed infrastructure adds up to

- ~ 150 000 units of residential buildings,
- ~ 3 000 units of education facilities,
- ~ 1 150 units of healthcare facilities.

Key findings during analysis stage



Difficulties on making first steps in planning due to the **escalated and continuing attacks**, a lot of uncertainty.



No current scheme from Lithuania or EU **for insurance** of people or equipment sent to Ukraine.



Ukraine's municipality regions are obliged to develop **their own long-term local development plans** according to the new law.

design visualization,




planning,

Urban territory under active rebuilding process.


• City of a ~50-100K residents.


A draft implementation plan containing stages of developing DPT for a selected Ukrainian city.


