Lithuania is about to turn a new page in its development cooperation. Growing political attention on this topic creates a favorable environment to review the long-term vision, principles, and goals of Lithuania's development cooperation. The conference aims to discuss the current state and future of Lithuania's development cooperation policy. The discussions will largely focus on the recommendations for development cooperation policy prepared by a project implemented by the Office of the President of the Republic of Lithuania, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Lithuania, and the "Create Lithuania" program. Presented recommendations propose key policy actions for strengthening the effectiveness of Lithuania's development cooperation. This conference offers new opportunities for public institutions, business and development cooperation communities, experts, and researchers to set a new vision and goals for Lithuania's future development cooperation policy.

MAIN QUESTIONS:

- What opportunities does Lithuania have to improve its development cooperation policy and what next steps should be taken in order to achieve a new level of effectiveness?
- What are Lithuania's development cooperation priorities and what new ideas should be taken into consideration?
- Should Lithuania reconfigure its presence in international development agencies?
- How can Lithuania increase its society's awareness and understanding of its development cooperation activities?
