- 🎯 **To prepare recommendations for the Government with proposed incentives and financial instruments necessary for such projects to be implemented.**

For the discussions, analytical materials, consisting of implemented project examples and required projects, defined by municipalities, will be distributed.

### CRITERIA

for a DHS project to be discussed in the **upcoming FGs**:

- Cost-effective solutions for modernization or installation of a biomass boiler house with installed capacity from 1MW to 20 MW
- Reasonable location of a source of biomass to DHS capacity unit (~ 50 km)
- Municipally owned district heating company as a partner
- Priority in the target group for the heat supply – municipally and state-owned consumers (hospitals, schools etc.)
- Project to be included in strategic development & sustainability plan of the community (in case there is one)
- Territorial priority for the project - northwest and central Ukraine

### DRAFT PROPOSALS INCLUDE:

1. Situation analysis
2. Definition of the problem:
  - Covering UA needs;
  - Theory of change;
  - Baseline - target - effect.
3. Financial framework.
4. Partnerships and actors involved:
  - Content leader/-s;
  - Formal implementer/-s, institution/-s;
  - Partners, counterparties in UA (confirmed by MoU) - ministries, municipalities and oblasts;
  - Beneficiary(-ies) and their involvement;
  - Responsible stakeholders from LT: institutions, partners.
